Responsibilities for pathologist assistant

- Participates in and assists in several functions of Histology and Cytology
- Assists in calling microfiche, daily comprehensive master log, Free Text and Delete logs, Billing Report
- Assist in the preparation and performance of routine surgical specimen dissection
- Select and prepare tissues for intraoperative frozen sections and / or touch imprints for cytological interpretation
- Evisceration and dissection of autopsy specimens
- Collaborate with Tissue Core personnel to procure research, time dependent tissue specimens
- Prepare gross photographs and tissues for monthly conferences
- Assist with resident orientation to Surgical Pathology
- Supervising daily work and routine activities in the potato testing laboratory
- Supervising summer testing and winter testing

Qualifications for pathologist assistant

- Bachelor's degree in biological sciences, allied health sciences or related field required
- 3-5 years experience working as a pathologist assistant in a complex medical center, with extensive experience handling large and complex surgical pathology specimens and performing post-mortem examinations, as typically attained with two or more years experience is required
- Must be eligible for AAPA Fellowship Examination and successfully complete

- Assist the SLP during assessment of students exclusive of administration and/or interpretation
- Follow documented treatment plans or protocols developed by the supervising SLP
- Document student performance (e.g., tallying data for the SLP to use
