- Serve as clinical instructor when a Physical Therapy Student affiliates at this facility
- Act as clinical coordinator of student affiliation program when assigned by Physical Therapy Supervisor
- Act as School Liaison Therapist as assigned by Clinical Supervisor
- Provide mandated services to assigned children on caseload in compliance with IEP documents utilizing the resources of the clinical Director of Rehabilitation
- Maintain accurate record keeping and IEP/IFSP goal tracking documentation
- Provide input into and when appropriate fabrication of child's assistive technology, adaptive equipment, and orthotic appliance needs
