## Responsibilities for pediatric physical therapist

- Provide home-based services for treatment of patients to relieve pain, develop and restore function
- Maintain maximum performance using appropriate physical therapy treatments, modalities and procedures as stated in the physical therapy plan of care
- Evaluate and regularly re-evaluate the rehabilitation needs of the patient
- Initiate, develop, implement and make necessary revisions of the patient's plan of care
- Assist with the coordination of the total plan of care
- Maintain continuity of patient care by liaising with other health professionals assigned to the same patients
- Providing screening, evaluation, and therapy services as assigned
- Providing consultations on issues involving effective motor development to teaching staff and other appropriate programs
- Daily note taking and progress reports, as required
- Evaluating and regularly re-evaluating the rehabilitation needs of the patient

## Qualifications for pediatric physical therapist

 Initiating, developing, implementing and making necessary revisions of the patient's plan of care to the same patients

- Treat children 3-21 years of age in a school
- Provide consultation on issues involving effective motor development to teaching staff and other appropriate programs
- Maintain and make all records and reports available required
