Responsibilities for pharmacist PRN

- Accurately profiling all medication orders while reviewing for allergies, drug interactions, rational drug therapy, and drug incompatibilities
- Overseeing purchases of supplies and medication
- Participating in all clinical programs as implemented by department
- Acting as a professional resource to all internal and external customers
- Counsels members and/or medical practitioners on drug indications/contraindications, dosage, drug interactions, and side effects
- Counsels members and/or medical practitioners on over the counter medication usage, indications/contraindications, dosage, drug interactions, and side effects
- Performs all dispensing functions
- Mixes irrigating solutions and intravenous additive solutions as required, using aseptic techniques with the Laminar arflow hood
- Maintains patient profiles
