Responsibilities for pharmacist PRN

- Actively participates in codes
- Facilitates or assists in the medication utilization evaluation process for service line
- Supports and participates in the goals of the organization's quality improvement, risk management, and patient safety programs to include but not limited to National Patient Safety Goals, Core Measures, and regulatory compliance and HCAHPS medication-related initiatives
- Demonstrates good leadership by developing standards of performance, determining areas of responsibility and accountability and delegating authority to various department staff members
- Establishes and evaluates standards of care
- Bachelor of Science degree in Pharmacy from an accredited college of pharmacy - Doctor of Pharmacy preferred
- Assist in ensuring that the pharmacy is in compliance with all DEA policies and
- Identify drug incompatibilities, duplication in therapies and report these to the practitioner
- Provide in-services/education to patients, nurses, physicians and other pharmacists as needed
