Responsibilities for pharmacy clinical

- Supervises and instructs pharmacists, residents, and pharmacy students
- Prepares and presents drug reviews, MUE criteria, antibiotic sensitivity reports, adverse drug reaction reports, and pharmacy interventions summary to the P&T committee
- Reviews and evaluates the medical literature for studies supporting the pharmaceutical care and pharmacoeconomic programs
- Reviews the performance and documentation of clinical activities of all pharmacists including documentation of the financial impact of clinical activities
- Coordinates policies and procedures for clinical activities (e.g., therapeutic interchange)
- Participates with the Director of Pharmacy in providing guidance to pharmacy staff regarding current TJC, state and other regulatory standards compliance
- Prepares reports on pharmaceutical care and pharmacoeconomic activities including financial impact, as directed
- Establishes productive, collaborative relationships with staff members and within the community
- Maintains current pharmacist licensure
- Sustains professional competence and promotes development through participation in inservices, workshops, seminars, and professional organizations

Qualifications for pharmacy clinical

- One to two years hospital clinical pharmacy experience preferred, with 1-2 years in a management position required
- Ability to use drug information resources
- 3 years as a clinical pharmacist
- Understanding of the components of a clinical service
- Experience in formulary management (i.e., P&T, MUE, and ADR reporting programs)
- Teaching experience such as that obtained during a Pharm.D., residency program, BCPS or other advanced pharmacy certification
