Responsibilities for pharmacy resident

- Understand all aspects of the medication use process
- Collaborate with multidisciplinary teams to assist with problem identification and resolution, cost containment issues, implementation of new services, and systems/performance measures
- Review, interpret and evaluate medication therapy to identify, prevent and resolve potential or actual drug related problems
- Develop, implement and evaluate programs, or area services and initiatives
- Provide drug information and education to clinicians, residents, students, and patients
- Mentor PharmD students
- Demonstrates knowledge of operational applications of departmental computer systems including identification and resolution of system issues
- Review microbiology data daily
- Support cost-effective formulary management
- Provide drug information and education as required

- Active participation in monthly
- Participates in clinical practice
- Bachelor of Science in pharmacy degree from an accredited college of pharmacy

- Maintains current unrestricted licensure as a licensed pharmacist in the State of Rhode Island
