## Responsibilities for pharmacy resident

- Assist the Clinical Manager with formulary requests
- Participate in investigational drug protocols as assigned
- Develop required reports
- Ensure that medication orders are processed timely, accurately and according to all legal, professional and departmental standards for dispensing and record keeping
- Manage the disposition of controlled substances, other dangerous drugs, and investigational drugs as required by Federal and State statutes and regulations
- Provides direct pharmaceutical care to the patient populations served
- Provides functional supervision to pharmacy operations in assigned work area
- Prepares reports, educates, makes suggestions and recommendations for improvement
- Performs other responsibilities and duties as assigned by the residency director or coordinator, or the individual rotational preceptors
- Participates in relevant hospital and pharmacy committees as part of the rotational or longitudinal research project activities
