- Screen medication orders for accuracy and resolves questions in consultation with a licensed pharmacist
- Deliver and/or exchange medication to the respective patient areas
- Accurately document pharmaceutical activities using automated and paper systems
- Appropriately deliver medications to automated dispensing cabinets (Pyxis)
- Assist with training of new technician employees in various responsibilities
