Responsibilities for plant maintenance manager

- Trains employees concerning plant and job hazards and the methods in order to protect themselves
- Works closely with leadership team to support continuous improvement activities to include daily improvement projects
- Lead, mentor, engage and develop teams to maximize their contributions, including recruiting, assessing, training, coaching and managing performance
- Coach employees by creating a shared understanding about what needs to be achieved and how it is to be achieved
- Ensure a safe and healthy work environment for all employees through proper maintenance of equipment and facilities while ensuring adherence to all applicable environmental, health and safety regulations, standards and policies
- Ensure reliability of production and distribution equipment and facility infrastructure for a 3 shift, 5-day/week (occasional 7 days/week and frequent holiday coverage) paint manufacturing and distribution operation
- Develop and implement preventive/predictive maintenance programs that engage workforce and cooperatively solves problems with other departments
- Efficiently develop and utilize people, equipment, materials, and utilities to meet plant and SBU requirements for safety, environment, quality, and cost (budget)
- Ensure maintenance department personnel are properly trained and skills are developed to achieve departmental requirements
