- Moves furniture and equipment (such as mattresses, beds and bedside stands) by use of handcarts or dollies
- Will perform the duties of housekeeping and laundry according to workload demands and staffing shortages and as scheduled
- Cleans and performs routine maintenance on equipment and reports equipment needing further repair

Qualifications for porter
