## Responsibilities for postdoctoral research associate

- Contribute to the development of research documentation for publication and/or preparing technical reports, patents, grants, papers, and/or records
- Supervise other lab personnel
- Contribute to the generation and maintenance of a work environment that is concurrently competitive and healthy, where all individuals can thrive and maximally contribute to the lab their own personal growth and success
- Supervision of graduate and undergraduate students
- Manuscript preparation and editing and conference presentations
- Design statistically-robust greenhouse, field, and lab experiments focused on screening for resistance to Fusarium wilt
