Responsibilities for problem management analyst

- Review the Problem Trends and Planning and Driving Improvement Plan from a Security perspective
- Be proactive in identifying problems, analyze and recommend Security Service Improvement plans with the possible solutions obtained from technical teams for department or business unit
- Identifies trends and potential Security Problem sources (by reviewing Security Incident and Problem analysis)
- Prevents the replication of Security Problems across multiple systems
- Maintains inventory of Security problems under analysis and their current progress and status
- Follows up Security issues and progress with problem owners where necessary
- Drive all Security problems towards root cause identification and permanent fix
- Conducts and facilitates the Root Cause Analysis(RCA) of a problem
- Conducts regular *incident and problem review- meetings with all parties involved to document actions taken to remediate the problem and actions needed
- Investigates problem and related data, provides analysis and presents findings to internal teams
