- Thorough review of volume reconciliations, valuation methodology and journal entries associated with manufactured and purchased products

  - Support the supply chain systems product owners in driving system enhancements and process improvement initiatives -- this role will focus on areas related to demand planning, order routing, and inventory management, but will also provide support in other areas as needed
  - Serve as the primary owner and support person for the JustEnough demand planning & forecasting application used by various supply chain operations groups
  - Gather, consolidate, and document business requirements for supply chain systems projects
  - Document current and future state business process flows including SOPs for supply chain systems projects and initiatives
  - Provide analysis for new project requests or change requests
  - Develop and manage systems process design flows for supply chain systems projects
  - Specify and recommend configuration changes for supply chain systems enhancements and process improvements, and assist in gathering modification requests
  - Develop and modify critical reports utilizing the supply chain systems, and work with business users to develop, analyze, and measure KPIs
