Responsibilities for production equipment operator

- Inserting experience preferred
- Recording data concerning amount and type of stock cut from duties performed, including weight, length, and width

- Changing ink per instructions
- Set up and operate a printing press to produce special occasion items such as invitations, napkins, holiday cards
- Changing ink cuts per instructions
- Expected to proactively identify and implement production improvements in their areas of responsibilities
- Operate and maintain semi-automated production equipment in a clean room
- Perform line clearances, cleaning/sanitization and preparing equipment for operation
- Weigh, measure and check raw materials to assure proper ingredients and quantities
