- Accountability for traditional administrative tasks of crew leaders
- Please not that the person in this role must be able and willing to work a rotating shift
- Report into the Plant Production Manager and be responsible for safety performance, production, quality and deadlines according to defined site schedules
- Coordinate all production activities within the unit and manage a team to ensure training and development needs are identified and delivered
- Establish, monitor and continually improve key performance indicators
