Responsibilities for production team

- Mixes product in mixing drums
- Confers with management and production personnel on sanitation problems and recommends changes in equipment, procedures or work practices to improve sanitation standards and product quality
- Working in a safe manner and following the SPQP guidelines (Safety, People, Quality, and Production)
- Practicing and promoting continuous improvements for manufacturing processes and identifying possible cost reduction opportunities
- Becoming part of the Modatek Team by effectively communicating and interacting with all levels of the organization
- Must certify on all departmental positions (learn to perform all departmental job functions and operate all departmental equipment) and provide relief and/or coverage as needed
- Utilize a computer terminal and Radio Frequency equipment, respond to computer generated instructions/directions
- Identify and compare numerical sequences, perform basic mathematics functions including addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division
- Operates packaging equipment (box erector, label machines, palletizer)
- Assists with general counting of inventory
