Responsibilities for production trainer

- Emphasis on safety and detail-oriented
- Forklift train the trainer experience, preferred
- Manage Area Resources to Maintain and Optimize Efficiency of Operations
- Depending on the needs of the department, trains and certifies TSMs in various skills specific to their area or in additional skills to work in other areas within the distribution center (may include certification on machines)
- Teach new hired employees how to perform the tasks required of them, different meat cuts, machine use, technique
- Stress to new hires the importance of work attendance and the vital role they fill on the line
- Manage multiple new hired employees at a time
- Familiarize new hires with where to find everything in the facility, including (but not limited to) the cafeteria, bathrooms, locker rooms, human resources
- Demonstrate new hires the proper way to use a knife and how to sharpen and maintain a blade
- Provide Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) training for the new hires according to the specifications of the areas they work in

Qualifications for production trainer
