Responsibilities for program operations specialist

- Maintain a comprehensive knowledge of all SafeRide policies and incident response protocols and effectively respond to and report incidents as they occur
- Liaising between UW ADVANCE, the College of Engineering's Human Resources Office, the UW Graduate School, and UW's Central Human Resources Office
- Applications reviews
- Provision of leadership related to the OPWDD self-direction model across the state
- Supervision of staff assigned as self-direction leads within Central Office
- Ongoing coordination and technical guidance for the DDRO based selfdirection liaisons
- Development and initiation of regulation and other guidance for the selfdirection model
- Ongoing engagement with stakeholder groups to facilitate input into the selfdirection model and related materials
- Ongoing coordination across bureaus and divisions in OPWDD to provide education and participate in overlapping work tasks
- Participation in quality oversight and audit tasks associated with the selfdirection model as needed
