Responsibilities for psychiatric registered nurse

- Directs and supervises licensed and unlicensed personnel in performance of their duties
- Provide admission, case management, and follow-up skilled nursing visits for behavorial home health patients
- Diagnose, manage and treat acute and chronic mental illness, including initiation of psychotropic medications and follow up to document progress and stability, including some case management responsibilities
- Supervise SHC Mental Health Social Worker
- Maintain accurate and timely documentation for all clinical interactions and consultations
- Attend case consultation and case review meetings
- You will oversee and direct the care of psychiatric patients within the Behavioral Health Department
- You will be the primary nurse leading the collaboration of all disciplines for well-coordinated care for your patients
- This Nurse oversees and directs the care of assisting personnel, maintaining final accountability for the care given to assigned patients
- When the need arises, will perform other duties as assigned by supervisor
