## Responsibilities for psychiatric registered nurse

- Participate in a multidisciplinary team
- Document and processe physicians orders
- Provide direct patient care, observation and management of behavioral health patients
- Assessment, plan and implement care and evaluating patients' progress towards expected outcomes
- Takes primary responsibility for the patients' care as delivered by the Care
   Team
- Manage de-escalation of behavioral disturbances
- Implements daily nursing care routines for youth assigned including the
  administration of medication, maintaining inventories of medication and
  nursing care items as needed, providing education about medications and
  other health concerns to youth and their families
- Oversees the general health of youth assigned by being cognizant of infection control concerns, scheduling medical appointments for youth as necessary and accompanying them to these appointments when assigned, and assists with physician rounds in collaboration with other treatment team members
- Provides appropriate medical and/or mental health emergency care to youth maintaining the health and safety of all youth assigned, and keeping the appropriate physician and administrative staff apprised of all untoward events
- Formulate plan of care for individual patients

- Unit safety search, documentation and management of sharps
- Enforces safety regulations and initiates corrective action for safety issues
- Limit setting and redirection of patients' behavior
- Maintains appropriate boundaries
