Responsibilities for psychiatric RN

- You will display effective communication skills as evidenced by the ability to maintain therapeutic relationships with patients, families, physicians and staff
- You must be able to set limits as needed by recognizing potential behavior problems and does so in a caring and consistent manner
- You must possess accurate knowledge of psycho-dynamics and therapeutic processes as demonstrated by effective intervention and resolution of problems as they occur, and communication of the processes to others
- You will oversee and direct the care of psychiatric patients within your assigned unit
- You will oversee and direct the care of assisting personnel, maintaining final accountability for the care given to assigned patients
- You will perform other duties as assigned by supervisor
- You will demonstrate clinical knowledge of psychiatric nursing and maintains highest quality of comprehensive patient care
- You will display effective communication skills and maintains therapeutic relationships with patients, families, physicians and staff

Qualifications for psychiatric RN

- Manages behavioral health escalations in proactively calm and professional manner seeking interventions to de-escalate promptly
- Minimum of one year experience in the acute care setting required
- Of patient care
