Responsibilities for psychologist

- Write P
- Contribute to the department's strategic initiatives to provide services and programs to a diverse student and resident population
- Other responsibilities and duties as assigned by the Senior Director
- Completes all required documentation within 24 hours of the service being rendered including supervision notes/evaluations, clinical interviews, and testing results including summaries and recommendations
- Documentation must be in compliance with insurance and major payer requirements
