Responsibilities for psychotherapist

- Develops treatment plan, documentation of client services and care
- To elaborate guidance documents on psychological aspects of VAWG/DV for different professionals inter alia investigators, prosecutors, judges, lawyers, employees of the State Fund for Protection and Assistance of (Statutory) Victims of Human Trafficking as necessary
- To conduct up to 30 training sessions for different professionals-investigators, judges, prosecutors or other professionals as necessary and elaborate respective reports regarding the conducted training
- To Conduct up to 10 information meetings with different target groups inter alia ethnic minorities, representatives of private companies on psychological aspects of VAW/DV and submit the respective reports regarding the conducted meetings to UN Women
- Responsible for conducting diagnostic assessments, determines clinical interventions, facilitates therapy and provides educations for patients and their families
- Responsible for development of transition/discharge plan
- Develops treatment plan, documents client services and care
- Individual counseling for undergraduate and graduate students
- Provide crisis intervention services for ongoing walk-in clients
- Facilitate psychiatric hospitalization for students as required

Qualifications for psychotherapist

- An LGSW engaged in clinical social work practice must be supervised by an

- Masters prepared Social Worker required
- 2+ years' experience providing mental Health therapy in an outpatient setting

- Master's degree from an accredited college in a human services program which provided preparation for profession counseling required
