Responsibilities for pump technician

- Communicates and collaborates with Employees from all areas of the facility
- Utilize computer to perform part search, log time and create spreadsheets
- Works on chilled and hot water systems, throttling valves, expansion tanks, heat exchangers, steam equipment and pump systems
- Repairs mechanical pumps, including seals, impellers, bearings and electric motors
- Analyzes and repairs pumps, drive motors (both hydraulic and electric), filtering systems, water treatment systems and chemicals, chemical injection systems, and sand filters
- Performs layout, design and installation of new pump systems the upgrading and refurbishing of older pump systems
- Performs daily, routine checks and maintenance of pumps and pumping systems
- Repairs and services pressure reducing valves, electric solenoid valves, water level controls, and steam valves/pumps
- Performs well system maintenance and sand filter maintenance including daily checks and adjusting/changing of packing
