Responsibilities for pump technician

- Troubleshoot well PLC using multi meter and LOI
- Repair and troubleshoot Beam POC end devices
- Troubleshoot radio communication by power cycling, checking link lights, and checking data communication cables and light, programming new radios for replacement
- Use Maximo to schedule work and perform failure coding on all tickets
- Repair and service hydraulic pumps
- Adhere to a schedule set forth by Foreman, including on-call duties
- Work hands-on in WSP products in a training role under a WSP Tech II or higher (minimum six months apprentice)
- Maintain work log detailing hours of training
- Learn to troubleshoot Fluid End issues on the WSP
- Safety – Supports the safety culture at the base by adhering to established safety procedures and expectations of compliance
