Responsibilities for QA technician

- Maintain, calibrate, and troubleshoot equipment such as
- Adhere food safety policies and all government food safety, sanitation, and quality regulations
- Follow the procedures systematically and understand each process
- Develop and maintain a thorough knowledge of the assigned applications, functional areas, and projects
- Taking part as a team in the final checkout process
- If QA tech work is not available at certain times during your shift, you are expected to fall back on tech work assistance, only until QA tech work once again resumes
- Analytical Procedures – Introduce new analysis into the laboratory
- Check and update the analytical standards that are used in the laboratory
- General quality control / quality assurance
- Environmental sampling activities
