- Liaise with other Field Supervisors and Contractor to be aware of planned and completed construction works to ensure Civil tests are planned and performed
- Monitor Contractor's Concrete Casting, Steel fixing, Anchor bolts, Grouting, Steel Structure erection, Block works, Soil & Excavation, Roads and Material-Receiving Quality Procedures implementation and QA/QC activities
