## Responsibilities for quality assurance representative

- Attend and contribute to production morning meetings
- Provides daily construction observation of construction contractors work
- Verify that all required preliminary actions have been taken such as submittal, review, and approval of shop drawings
- Performs random quality audits on all functions within the assigned departments and facilities according to established procedures at the direction of the Quality Audit Supervisor
- Audits for Phone, E-mail, Chat, IWF, and future Customer Care responsibilities that may come
- Audit information is entered on the quality audit form within the QA
   Application system(s) where it generates reporting results to Employees,
   Supervisors, Managers and Production Accounting
- Determines if Acceptable Quality Level (AQL) pass/fail guidelines are met as required
- Provides written documentation of audit results to the Supervisors, Managers and Production Accounting on a weekly basis
- Conduct in-process and final inspections of all aircraft, engine, aircrew, ordnance or other related systems maintenance tasks which require a QA Representative sign-off per customer/company directives/publications
- Ensure check pilots and aircrew are briefed before post maintenance FCFs so the purpose and objectives of the flight are clearly understood

- Tire and Wheel Certified As Required
- Ordnance Certified As Required
- Hydraulic Qualified As Required
- Experience with laboratory construction projects is preferred
- Experience with clean room construction and testing is preferred
- Experience with Bluebeam and other jobsite technologies is preferred
