Responsibilities for quality program manager

- Lead key quality initiatives that will evolve quality management system
- Lead meetings to drive process discussion, drive decisions with Quality goals in mind
- Identify risks and develop risk mitigation techniques, Identify, track, prioritize and drive resolution of issues and work to address and mitigate systemic issues
- Ensure escalations are done in a timely manner to the right individuals
- Identify and track major milestones for the program and/or project
- Monitor and measure progress to ensure that the program & project meet or exceed performance target, ensuring that teams document accurate status
- Uphold the highest standards and clinical integrity in assigned quality, safety, and/or practice initiatives—Maintains professional and industry standards in assuring all clinical decisions, content, and impacts are appropriate in context of professional standards, current evidence-based recommendations, and clinical standards or guidelines
- Lead and manage nursing and clinical quality, safety, and/or practice initiatives for assigned accountabilities – Plans, leads and manages defined clinical initiatives
- Coordinate creation of standard processes to promote adoption –
 Collaborate with Clinical Decision Teams, Nursing Education & Adoption
 Team, and quality and clinical leaders as applicable to define, create, and
 provide ongoing evaluation of effective process for adoption of clinical
