Responsibilities for radiologic technologist

- Assists the physicians in the performance of specialized examinations such as IVP, BE, or other procedures by preparing rooms and passing instruments and supplies as needed
- Utilizes portable x-ray equipment to execute diagnostic procedures in patient's rooms, surgery, and fluoroscopy room and in other instances when patients cannot come to the department
- Maintains a Flouro log for all procedures
- Assist in transporting patients within the center
- Perform radiographic/CT examinations in accordance with national and state licensure requirements
- Evaluate film for technical quality
- Direct patient care including transportation of patients
- Adheres to radiation precaution standards while working in the medical imaging area
- Assist patient flow through out and between departments
- Assists in maintaining accuracy of records, files and billing information

Qualifications for radiologic technologist

- A valid and current license by the state in which employed, if state offers a licensing certification program
- Valid and current registration with The American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT), or have valid and current registration with an

- State of Florida licensure or licensure eligibility required
- Florida State Radiation License required
