Responsibilities for radiology technologist

- This position performs routine and emergency radiographic and fluoroscopic procedures, including procedures in surgery, in accordance with the departmental policy and procedure manual and the Radiologist's request, producing exams of acceptable technical quality
- Utilize the Radiology Information System/Picture Archiving and Communication systems effectively
- Assist with teaching students of the Radiologic Technology School/Program
- Accountable for the success of the department to achieve hospital designated Press Ganey mean score
- Perform other duties assigned and help in other areas as needed. Possible on call and holidays required
- The Radiological Technologist performs a variety of technical procedures that require rational independent judgement, ingenuity, and initiative in performing standard examinations in the diagnosis and treatment of disease
- Critique film quality and adjust technical factors to improve image quality
- Have knowledge of film management system for all locations
- Perform high quality digital mammography, digital x-ray, DEXA, and Fluoroscopy exams on incoming patients
- Respond to physician questions and assist with breast biopsies / procedures as needed

Qualifications for radiology technologist

- Must maintain Registry and evidence of (AMA/JCAHO approved) credits of continuing education
- Minimum 2 years of previous management experience preferred
- Six months to be fully proficient
- Certified through the American Heart Association to provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
- Anatomy, information system use, image quality
