Responsibilities for radiology technologist

- Responsible to assist with the provision of patient care to meet identified patient outcomes, and to achieve the goals of the facility as directed by the Clinical Leader/Registered Nurse
- Orients the patient and family to the patient care environment and facility routines
- Evaluates radiographs for technical quality and stores pictures according to facility policy and guidelines
- Ensures that internal customers, technical staff and upper management are kept aware of project status, issues and escalations
- Work with operation and finance leaders on large scale project activities
- Monitor, organizes and expedites flow of work through supervisor's office
- Coordinates and schedules regular or ad-hoc site and regional physician meetings and system leadership
- Meets with external entities in planning, coordinating and executing special events or meetings
- Manages own projects as assigned by department leadership team, with responsibility for meeting deadlines
- Performs computer-based correspondence, documents, charts and reports
