Responsibilities for reg respiratory therapist

- Participates in the development and implementation of policies, procedures, and algorithms
- Performs application of oxygen therapy appropriate to clinical needs as determined by pulse oximetry and/or arterial blood gas analysis as appropriate to age for patient population newborn through adult
- Provides emergency life support in accordance to age for patient population newborn through adult
- Patient Care. Review and evaluate history, physical exams, current vital signs, admission and current respiratory care orders for each patient
- Planning & Documentation
- Education & Communication
- Demonstrates these skills by successfully completing examinations administered by the National Board for Respiratory Care (NBRC) and earning the credential CRT
- Provide diagnostic services and non-invasive monitoring including pulse oximetry, arterial and venous blood procurement, capnography, pulmonary function testing, apnea screening, bronchoscopy assistance, and EKG procurement
- Supervises and conducts exercise training programs for PR patients
- Supervises and conducts on-going assessments, six minute walk test, PHQ9, and Dartmouth

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- Demonstrates knowledge of pulmonary rehab admission/exclusion criteria
 - Performs application of oxygen therapy appropriate to clinical needs determined by pulse ox
 - Associate degree in Respiratory Care required by department
 - Registered Respiratory Therapist per National Board of Respiratory Care (NBRC) and licensed by the state of Michigan - required by department
 - 1-2 years working with chronic lung disease population
 - Administers and assess responses to respiratory therapeutic interventions with high proficiency and minimal to no supervision
