Responsibilities for registered dietitian

- Participates in facility-wide and department program on performance improvement to improve processes and patient care
- Develops and modifies education materials for patients and family to meet their learning needs
- Communicates nutrition plans of care with medical team members, patients and families through verbal, written or electronic communication
- Serves as preceptor for dietetic interns and medical residents as assigned
- Performs all responsibilities/duties required by Registered Dietitian as defined in the scope of practice, to ensure that the needs of patients are addressed
- Provides in-service education as required to staff
- Provides in-services and education to hospital staff as requested
- Provides medical nutrition therapy and nutrition consultation to inpatients and/or outpatients when requested by physician, other hospital staff, or as required by department policy
- Provides nutritional care to inpatients and/or outpatient
- Provides patient education and documentation

Qualifications for registered dietitian

- Knowledge of and familiarity with The American Dietetic Association Guidelines for the preparation of regular and special diets
- The ability to translate the science of nutrition into everyday information about food
