## Responsibilities for registered nurse coordinator

- Works with Beacon Health leadership and Ortho, LLC leadership in the development, design, implementation and evaluation of the specialty orthopedic care model
- Implement monitoring systems for orthopedic patients to prevent and/or intervene early to ensure appropriate level of care services provided
- Works with Ortho, LLC providers to ensure appropriate standing orders or protocols are in place for services
- Provides regular progress updates to Ortho, LLC providers, PCP and other members of the care team
- Collaborates with the Transitional Care Coordinators and Inpatient/Outpatient Care Management staff to ensure smooth process in place when movement between settings occurs
- Provides onsite inpatient visits to Mercy to serve as a liaison for orthopedic surgical patients
- Overseeing clinical Medicaid reimbursement and utilization services at assigned centers
- Directing and overseeing the implementation of Kindred's utilization
