



Example of Registered Nurse Emergency Room Job Description

Responsibilities for registered nurse emergency room

- A registered professional nurse is responsible for delivery of patient care through the nursing process of assessment, planning, implementation and evaluation
- Must be able to perform all functions of the staff R.N., triage responsibilities, and demonstrates competence with all Emergency Room procedures
- The Registered Nurse in this department provides care for birth to pediatric, pediatric/child patients between 1 to 11 years of age
- The Registered Nurse provides therapeutic and administrative services necessary for the care of the patient, and in support of the mission of Lee's Summit Medical Center Hospital
- The Emergency Department RN will obtain a broad spectrum of nursing skills and should be able to handle the stresses of a crisis situation and still display a tolerant, calm appearance and professional attitude
- They will coordinate with ancillary departments for the provision of treatment and care of emergency department patients and the orderly transfer of patients
- He/she must work effectively with fellow employees from all units
- He/she should also be able to delegate authority and accept responsibility for own actions and the actions of those under their supervision
- They must fulfill the standard of professional ethics and demonstrate exceptional customer service skills while acting as a role model and resource

- Formulates a plan of care based on trends of similar patients, including patient education and discharge planning

Qualifications for registered nurse emergency room

- 1 year of emergency room acute care experience preferred
- AHA BLS Certification -- within two (2) weeks of employment
- AHA ACLS Certification-- within eight (8) weeks of employment
- ENPC Certification -- within twelve (12) months of employment
- TNCC Course -- within twelve (12) months of employment
- Arrhythmia Recognition Course -- within eight (8) weeks of employment
