- Responsible for assisting the Director of Nursing in the investigating, documenting and reporting of any incidents
- Meet the state specific educational requirements for the nursing supervisory position
- Sets priories and prepares schedules to ensure completion of work
- Staffs and assigns work based on priorities, requirements of assignments and capabilities of subordinates
- Gives advice, counsel or instructions to personnel on work and administrative matters
- Hears and resolves complaints of staff
- Recommends and/or takes disciplinary action where appropriate
- Identifies development and training needs for staff and provides/coordinates training
- Analyzes performance improvement data and establishes action plans for improvement

## Qualifications for registered nurse unit

Must be a graduate of an accredited School of Nursing program, BSN

- Ortho and or Neuro care experience preferred
- Bachelor's degree in nursing, required within 5 years of employment
- One (1) year of RN experience in an acute or sub-acute/LTAC hospital setting, required
