## Responsibilities for rehabilitation technician

- Communicates effectively in documentation and verbally with patients, family, medical staff, care team members, students, supervisor and outside contacts
- Maintains equipment and facilities by adhering to facility policy in maintenance of treatment areas, equipment and supplies
- Maintain established departmental policies, procedures, and objectives participation in improving organization performance program, safety, environmental, and infection control programs and adherence to policies regarding such matters
