Responsibilities for rehabilitation technician

- Utilize appropriate resources when indicated to resolve conflicts, solve problems, and achieve goals
- Maintain knowledge of the provision of individualized age specific care
- Implement specified portions of the treatment plan and demonstrate competency in procedures in physical therapy as delineated by the California State Practice Guidelines including
- Complete all required documentation as required by departmental policies and procedures
- Provide training in Physical Therapy treatment methods and techniques, and ensures optimal carry-over of treatment program with staff and family
- Participate in patient care, departmental, and medical center meetings
- Perform non-patient related tasks that are essential to departmental operations
- Assist with scheduling, equipment procurement, supplies maintenance, and environment of care
- Assistance with patient care for a new 25-bed inpatient rehab unit
- Communicates effectively in the documentation and verbally with patients, family, medical staff, care team members, students, supervisor and outside contacts

Qualifications for rehabilitation technician

- 3 months of Long-term care or related geriatric and/or rehabilitative

- A minimum of six months prior work/volunteer experience providing individual instructions in a health care environment is preferred
- Previous experience in patient care in a rehabilitation center is preferred
- Able to relate and work with the disabled, ill, elderly, emotionally upset and at times, hostile people within the facility
