

Example of Research RN Job Description

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Our growing company is looking to fill the role of research RN. If you don't fill all of the qualifications, you may still be considered depending on your level of experience.

Responsibilities for research RN

- This individual must be able to work independently under limited supervision, while maintaining excellent communication between the principal investigator(s) and all staff involved in any aspect of approved research projects
- Depending on the requirements of a specific protocol, other duties may be assigned based upon the NRC's qualification, training, experience and licensure, when applicable
- Function under the supervision of the Director, Clinical Research Operations, to assist in leading the Research service line in implementing and developing clinical trial process and procedures to expand clinical trial access to patients across the region
- Be responsible for supervision of a Clinical Research Coordinator or Data Coordinator supporting the research service line and coordinating and maintaining diverse activities related to clinical trials across the California region
- Coordinate implementation of protocol treatment, care, management and follow up of patients enrolled on highly complex research studies
- Be primarily responsible for patient eligibility verification, coordination of tests and procedures, education of patients, families, Nursing and Medical staff, coordination of investigational vaccines and oral agents, patient advocacy, and assurance of compliance with Federal and International Human Subjects Regulations

- Administers chemotherapy as ordered by physicians
- Collaborates with the SRL, physicians of the practice and research committee in the process of study selection for the research program

Qualifications for research RN

- Meticulous attention to detail and confidentiality
- Special Skills and Abilities Required Rating of solid/Strong/Good or higher on most recent performance evaluation May supervise nonprofessional staff
- 2-years Clinical Nursing experience in an acute care and or ambulatory setting required
- Functions as a leader for the research team by serving others, anticipate their needs and utilize problem solving strategies
- Ability to train others in obtaining a 12 lead EKG
- Demonstrates competency in patient education (i.e., cardiovascular diagnosis, disease management and interventional procedures)
