Responsibilities for research RN

- Organizational management of all aspects of the clinical trial, including but not limited to, timeliness in completing case report forms, data entry, reporting adverse drug experiences, managing caseload and managing patient/data study file
- Using established criteria and structured assessments, perform proactive telephone outreach and comprehensive screening of frail patients for palliative care needs and link patients to appropriate KP and non-KP services and programs to address unmet medical and non-medical social needs
- Using established criteria, screen incoming referrals for patient appropriateness for home-based palliative care (HBPC) and triage patients who do not qualify for HBPC to other appropriate services and programs
- Undergo training as a Life Care Planning instructor in order to train and mentor clinicians on advance care planning conversations (Last Steps)
- Undergo other advanced training in palliative care practice as needed to serve as a resource and mentor to other palliative care clinicians
- Other assigned responsibilities from the research project manager to meet study deliverables and milestones
