Responsibilities for resident pharmacist

- Ensure optimal medication use throughout the entire medical center across all ages of the patient population
- Perform all of the functions of an Inpatient Pharmacist under the direct supervision of a Pharmacist, when not appropriately licensed
- Follow all applicable state and federal regulations
- Be responsible for learning and then performing all functions related to medication use over a one year period beginning July 1st to June 30th
- Review and interpret physician's orders to assure that the drug, dosage form, and dose is appropriate for the patient's age, weight, condition and comorbidities
- Review patient records and orders regarding drug therapy
- Regularly consult with physicians and nursing staff members concerning the use, availability, dosage form, side effects and possible incompatibilities of new currently used drugs
- Follow proper computer order entry procedures
- Document all clinical interventions and workload statistics
- Complete required rotation objectives, evaluations, residency project, presentations and other assignments

Qualifications for resident pharmacist

- Ability of operate Computer VDT Terminals for extended periods
- Graduate from an accredited college or university of pharmacy

Alaska State Board of Pharmacy during the residency

- Flexible schedule to accommodate department needs
- Previous experience in hospital pharmacy practice as a student, intern or pharmacist
- Participate in the clinical evaluation and care of patients in a variety of patient care settings with sufficient frequency to achieve the competencies required by their discipline under the direct supervision of the attending staff
