Responsibilities for respiratory therapy

- Neonatal emergency intubation will be required within 90 days
- ACCS and/or NPS credential preferred
- Must be expert in adult ventilator management
- The Respiratory Care Services Manager is accountable and responsible for the quality of services and care rendered by the Respiratory Care Staff
- Effectiveness and efficiency in performing supervisory duties are essential to maintaining this position
- The Manager directly oversees the operation of the department including all respiratory care clinical functions (diagnostic and therapeutic), assigned financial and benchmarking data, quality improvement processes
- Creates, updates, maintains, instructs and coaches staff in the daily clinical service procedures provided by the department
- Responsible for assuring correct, appropriate, safe and timely RT care is provided by employees
- Looks for creative methods to resolve problems and/or avoid issues
- Takes responsibility and proactively makes decisions in the best interest of the patient

Qualifications for respiratory therapy

- Minimum of CRT with registry eligible
- Master's degree and graduate of an accredited Respiratory Therapy program
- 5 years respiratory therapy experience, and 3 years in supervisory role

- High school diploma or the equivalent and graduation from an AMA approved respiratory therapy program required
- Must be registered with the National Board for Respiratory Care
