- Assist with care, calibration and maintenance of all equipment
- Respond to emergency resuscitation team calls
- Evaluate respiratory practice, administration of medications, and treatment based on patient outcome
- Respond to emergency resuscitation team code
- May work with adult, pediatric, and neonatal patient populations
- Performs comprehensive respiratory assessment and respiratory therapy as prescribed by a physician

- Must be registered with the National Board for Respiratory Care (NBRC)
