Responsibilities for risk management specialist

- Supports activities of the patient safety triage team/grievance committee(s)
 and serves on other patient care and safety related committees as member,
 or ex officio, as needed to communicate findings, recommendations, actions,
 and results
- Fosters and maintains collaborative relationships with external agencies
- Reviews documented patient, family, and visitor concerns, complaints and grievances provided by the Patient Advocate
- Attends and supports departmental/hospital meetings where measurement and evaluation functions are performed as agreed upon by the Director of Quality and Safety
- Attends Quality and Patient Safety Committee meetings collaborative group meetings when performance improvement is indicated
- Assists departments with integration of quality and risk activities
