Responsibilities for rn-emergency department

- Utilizes current evidence and research in practice
- Develops and maintains a professional relationship with members of the health care team, the patient and the patient's family
- Delegates, directs and supervises implementation of care plan to LPN, PCT, or other health care workers
- Uses the nursing process to provide care for any patient presenting to the department
- Fairview Southdale Hospital Emergency Department is part of the seven county metropolitan-wide emergency medical service network
- The Emergency Department consists of 44 multifunctional private rooms
- The Emergency Department has both an ambulatory and EMS/ambulance entrance
- The department is a Level 3 Trauma Center
- The Fairview Ridges (located in Burnsville, MN) ER processes 66,000 cases per year, with an average of 181 patients seen daily
- Accountable for safety, identify and corrects problem, and integrate evidence, and best practice into nursing care

Qualifications for rn-emergency department

- ACLS within six (6) months of start date and must maintain recognition
- Mobile Intensive Care Nurse Certification (MICN) within one (1) year of start date and must maintain recognition
- Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) recognition within six (6) months of start date and must maintain recognition
- Two years emergency room experience preferred, or candidates with relevant critical care experience may be considered
