Responsibilities for rn-emergency department

- Unencumbered RN license in state(s) of hire, and wherever care is delivered
- Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) within 90 days of hire
- Emergency Nurse Pediatric Course (ENPC) within 6 months upon hire
- Trauma Nursing Core Course (TNCC) within 6 months upon hire
- Sugar Temperature Airway Blood pressure Labwork and Emotional responsibility (STABLE) within 6 months upon hire
- 1 year experience in Acute care experience working with the patient population similar to department of hire or completion of the specialty residency located at that facility

Qualifications for rn-emergency department

- Basic Life Support (BLS) AHA required
- PALS, ACLS, & CPI within 6 months of hire
- One year acute care Emergency Room (ER) Registered Nurse (RN) experience within the last three years preferred
- You need to be licensed as an RN in Maryland (or other Nurse Licensure Compact state) and have your American Heart Association BLS/CPR and ACLS
- You will need to have your Associates' Degree in Nursing
- At a minimum, we need you to have 1+ years' experience in a fast-paced
