Responsibilities for rn-emergency department

- Must have at least two years current RN Emergency Department
- At least 12 months of acute care nursing experience
- Recent Emergency Department nursing experience highly preferred
- Current California Registered Nurse (RN) licensure
- ACLS, PALS, & CPI required within 6 months
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Qualifications for rn-emergency department

- Trauma Nursing Core Course (TNCC) within 6 months of hire
- Emergency Nurse Pediatric Course (ENPC) within 6 months of hire
- Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) upon hire
- Must have at least three years current RN Emergency Department
- Must have Emergency Department Charge Nurse experience
- ACLS certification must be completed prior to end of orientation
