## Responsibilities for rn-infusion

- Reviews laboratory values and responds accordingly, , ordering blood products PRN, adjusting EPO doses per clinical pathway, and initiating neutropenic or bleeding precautions PRN
- Performs peripheral IV, central venous, port-a-cath access, lad draws via central lines or port-a-caths, removal of PICC lines as necessary
- Provide professional, comprehensive nursing care for patients in an oncology clinic or infusion center environment
- Have functions and specific skills for the job are found in the unit specific on boarding checklist and in standards that are applicable to the specialty
- Assess and monitor patients using appropriate technical skills under the direction and supervision of a physician
- Administers chemotherapy and biotherapy
- Provides nursing coverage for the satellite offices as needed including Radiation Oncology
- Checks dressings and reports abnormalities to the surgeon
- Performing appropriate patient education
- Performing routine triage tasks and recording vital signs

## Qualifications for rn-infusion

- ONS/ONCC Chemotherapy Biotherapy Certificate within 1 year
- Minimum of 1 year nursing experience, Oncology/Chemo experience strongly

- Experience and knowledge of the purpose and use of medications in the treatment of cancer is preferred
- Minimum of 1 year of RN experience required, preferably in an oncology environment
- 0-3 years of RN experience required, preferably in an oncology environment
